## 2011 CAWP Kids Construction Safety Calendar Contest

The Constructors Association of Western Pennsylvania (CAWP) is having its 4th Annual CAWP Kids Construction Safety Calendar Contest. Entry is open to the children, grandchildren, nieces, and nephews of CAWP and H2AP contractors, CAWP Associate members who perform onsite services, and heavy / highway Union members.

The contest will be broken down into four age groups with three winning drawings selected from each age group for a total of twelve winning entries. The twelve winning entries will be featured in the 2011 CAWP Kids Construction Safety Calendar.

The three winning entries from each age group will receive the following prizes:

**1st Place winners will receive a \$1,500 savings bond**

**2nd Place winners will receive a \$750 savings bond**

**3rd Place winners will receive a \$500 savings bond**



Before the children begin to draw, we urge you to talk to them about what safety means to you and your family. Explain the measures you take to be safe on the job and how they allow you to safely return home to them each and every day. Discuss key issues like the importance of personal protective equipment, highway work zone safety, trench safety, working around heavy equipment, fall protection, maintaining a drug-free workplace, and general safety awareness. Drawings related to work zone safety may be utilized during our work zone safety campaign in April 2011. We hope this discussion is a positive experience for you and your family about the importance of safety on the job and at home.

The entry form is attached and contest rules are to the right. Be sure to read all the rules carefully so that all drawings will be eligible. Good luck!

### Contest Entry Rules

1. Entry is open to the children, grandchildren, nieces, and nephews of CAWP and H2AP contractors, CAWP Associate members who perform onsite services, and heavy / highway Union members- between the ages of 5 and 12. There are 4 age groups with 3 winners from each age group: 1) ages 5-6, 2) ages 7-8, 3) ages 9-10, 4) ages 11-12.
2. The drawing must relate to construction safety. Encourage your children to be creative.
3. **The finished drawing MUST be an 11" x 8.5" landscape on white paper.** ONLY crayons or colored pencils should be used.
4. Only one entry per child will be allowed. Parents/relatives are limited to verbal assistance only.
5. All drawings must be an individual effort and be free-hand originals. No traced pictures or trademarked images, i.e. fictitious characters, although company logos are encouraged.
6. Each drawing must have the entry form completed and attached to the back of the drawing to be eligible.

8. Judging criteria will be based on creativity and how well the drawing expresses the contest theme of construction safety.

## HOW TO ENTER

### Contest Entry Rules

1. 2. The drawing must relate to construction safety. Encourage your children to be creative.
3. **The finished drawing MUST be an 11" x 8.5" landscape on white paper.** ONLY crayons or colored pencils should be used.
4. Only one entry per child will be allowed. Parents/relatives are limited to verbal assistance only.
5. All drawings must be an individual effort and be free-hand originals. No traced pictures or trademarked images, i.e. fictitious characters, although company logos are encouraged.
